## History

We have been working to connect our community through various projects since **2015**. In **2018** after a survey we started working with all family members teaching English and tutoring in school subjects. **August 18, 2020** We were incorporated as **Cultures Learning Together Inc.** and received our 501(c)(3) status in the beginning of **2021**.

Since **2018** we have already supported 164 students and tutors who represent at least **13 different countries** and cultures from the Americas, Europe, and Asia.

## What distinguishes our work?

**First:** we are a **win-win program** because we are a team of learners, tutors and non-English speakers, both **teaching and learning from each other** as **global citizens**.

**Second:** We are **family-oriented**. A greater understanding of English in all family members **breaks down barriers** and **strengthens the ties between the family and the community, empowering adults** to be the link with the community and **avoiding the stressful responsibility of having children serve as translators**. . Additionally, children receive **tutoring in other school subjects**.

## Why is it important?

**Our college students** are better able to appreciate and accept the diversity in our world with increased exposure to differences and are able to understand these differences as future global citizens.

**Our migrant farmworker families** have the language to communicate facilitating their belonging to our community. Their cultural understanding facilitates the process of adaptation between them and their children in our
